The Executive Committee exists to support the Group Scout Leader in meeting the responsibilities of their appointment.

Members of the Executive Committee must act collectively as charity trustees of the Scout Group, and in the best interests of its members.

Who can vote

You can only vote if you are a member of the Group Scout Council. This includes:

- Scouters
- Colony, Pack and Troop Assistants
- Administrators
- Advisers
- Patrol Leaders
- All parents of Beavers Scouts, Cubs Scouts and Scouts
- any other supporters including former Scouts and their parents who may be admitted by the Group Scout Leader, the Group Executive Committee or the Group Scout Council



How to vote

- There are a number of elected positions for the Group Executive Committee.
 - We have less nominees then places, so we do not need to conduct a ballot.
 - The candidates will still need to be approved individually by registering your vote using the on-line form.
- Some other positions are nominated by the Group Scout Leader but require your approval.
 - This is done on the same form.
- If there are more than one person voting in the household please submit separate forms.


Lynda Canham

I love having an input into what activities and plans the group will be able to offer going forward and give a little back to all the wonderful leaders who have helped my children progress and grow.






Nicole McNally
